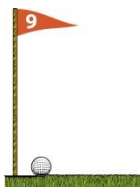

June 10 - First Aid Supplies – donated to the Red Cross - Gauze, bandages, Band-Aids

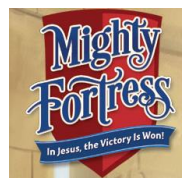


St. John's Lutheran Church along with Trinity Lutheran Church in Muskegon will be volunteering their services to help out Camp Restore in Detroit.
