

Preschool Bible Lesson

Goals and Objectives

1. To develop a **SPIRITUAL** awareness of God's love so that your child will learn the difference between right and wrong and in doing, learn how a child of God acts.
2. To develop **SOCIALLY** by learning to play together with others, learning to share toys and working materials.
3. To develop **MENTALLY** through the use of various educational materials in the recognition of his/her name and other names, the recognition of shapes, colors and numbers.
4. To develop **PHYSICALLY** by forming good health habits, and developing the use of large and small muscles skills.
5. To develop **EMOTIONALLY** in recognizing ones own feelings about him/herself and others, and how to respond to those feelings.
6. To develop **ARTISTICALLY** through experiences in music and creative art.

Enrollment Procedures

There are three ten-week sessions within the school year beginning in September and ending in the middle of May. Pre-school has a flex schedule which allows you to pick a schedule option that works best for your family. Schedule options are 2 day a week, 3 day a week or 5 day a week.

Each morning class runs from 8:15 am - 11:15 am.

- ◇ **The cost for Preschool two days a week is \$110.00 a month for eight months.**
- ◇ **The cost for the three days a week is \$150. a month for 8 months.**
- ◇ **The cost for 5 days a week is \$195.00 a month for 8 months.**
- ◇ **There is a \$60. non refundable registration fee due at the time of registration.**

We also offer a class on Monday-Friday afternoons for young fives who are ready for more of a challenge, but not ready for Kindergarten. If interested please contact the school office. The afternoon classes

Typical Day in Preschool

A typical day at St. John's Lutheran Preschool includes the following:

- Manipulative puzzles and games.
- Circle time which includes Show-n-Tell, Theme for the day and Calendar exercises.
- Art includes both group and individual projects working with paint, scissors, glue, paper, and other materials.
- Free play consists of 45—60 minutes of free play with different toys available, painting easels, play dough, rice table, blocks, kitchen, large trucks, etc..
- Snack time - We ask the parents to contribute snacks, drinks, napkins, cups, etc.
- Group activity large musical activity, rhythm sticks, bean bags or musical instruments, songs and finger plays or outside play weather permitting.
- Story—We end the day with a story or two and dismiss the children to waiting parents.
